inemaking pioneer <u>Randall</u> <u>Grahm</u> planted Rhône varieties in the Santa Cruz mountains of northern California in 1981. Named after the small town of Bonny Doon, the eponymous brand is intrinsically linked to the Central Coast terroir and its unique culture. Four decades later, Grahm continues to lead winemaking at Bonny Doon Vineyard, working alongside long-time colleague, Nicole Walsh.

Ever the innovator, Randall and the Bonny Doon story has become iconic in the California Rhône Wine Movement.

Timeline & Highlights

1983 Founding of the Bonny Doon Vineyard brand.

1986 The first vintage of flagship wine Le Cigare Volant is released. An homage to Chateauneuf du Pape, the old-world style label, featured a (spaceship) hovering over the vineyards. (note: The spaceship has become synonymous with the brand, escalating to include alien visuals on screw cap closures, case cartons and point of sale materials.)

1989 Grahm appears as the Rhône Ranger on the cover of the Wine Spectator.

Issue includes first ever comprehensive tasting of domestic Rhône-style wines.

1991 Rhône Ranger asteroid is named.

2001 BDV adopts screw cap closures on all wines.

2002 Funeral for

the Cork is staged at Grand Central Station, NY. Jancis Robinson delivers eulogy.

2010 Randall

Grahm is inducted into Vintner's Hall of Fame at Culinary Institute of America.

2018 Food & Wine Magazine publishes "Forty Wines that Changed the Way We Drink" including Le Cigare Volant.

2019 The 2018 Le Cigare Volant is released with new, brighter blend and winemaking style. Wine Enthusiast awards 93 Points and #19 on top 100 Wines of the World.

2021 Wine Enthusiast, again, awards 93 Points & top 100 Wines of the World to the '19 Le Cigare Volant.
